**EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION OF THE APPLICANT**

- Minimum Class 10/Matriculation or above from affiliated educational institution attended Full-Time with a minimum of 45% in any of the preceding examinations
  - \*Marksheets and Pass Certificate required
